# **SUBMISSION GUIDLINES**

- 1. The paper should have an Abstract containing 200-300 words with 4-6 keywords.
- 2. The Abstract should be in Italies, with Times New Roman font, 1.5 line spacing and font size 12. 3.For the main paper, use 12-point Times New Roman font with 1.5 line spacing and one-inch margins, (MS Word)
- 4. The paper should comply with the APA format and sources should be cited according to APA guidelines.
- 5. The bibliography must be added at the end of the paper.
- 6. The word limit including the abstract must be 2500-3000 words.
- 7. The paper should be in English and the language must be clear and precise.
- 8. Registration and fee remission have to be done using the link provided.
- 9. The paper should be uploaded through the registration link along with the proof of the remitted fee.
- 10. Only one co-author is allowed.
- 11. If the paper has a co-author, each should register separately.
- 12.Selected papers will be intimated via mail on the 3rd December and the PPT for the same should be prepared using MS PowerPoint.
- 13. Participants can opt for either online or offline presentations.
- 14.The selected participants will have a presentation time of 7 minutes followed by the Q&A Sessions.
- 15. Selected papers will be published in an ISBN publication.
